Persons under 18 years of age who are employed as actors are exempt from the Alabama Child Labor Law provided: 1) the studio or movie set is approved by the Alabama Entertainment Office and inspected by the Alabama Department of Labor; 2) the work will not be detrimental to the life, health, safety, welfare, or morals of the child; 3) the activities will not interfere with the child=s education (which must be equivalent to full-time attendance in the public schools for persons under 16 years of age); and 4) actors under 16 years of age are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or responsible adult at all rehearsals, appearances and performances.
